How Infinite Atom Responds to Legal Demands

// 1. PURPOSE

This policy describes how Infinite Atom Technologies LLC responds to legal demands from law enforcement, government agencies, and private parties seeking user data or platform information. We are committed to protecting user privacy while complying with our legal obligations.

// 2. OUR COMMITMENT TO USER PRIVACY

Infinite Atom Technologies LLC does not voluntarily share user data with law enforcement, government agencies, or third parties without legal process. We believe in your right to privacy and will not assist surveillance beyond what the law requires. We scrutinize all legal demands carefully and will push back on demands that are overbroad, legally deficient, or improperly served.

// 3. TYPES OF LEGAL DEMANDS

3.1 Subpoenas

A valid subpoena compels production of specified records. We require subpoenas to be properly served, identify the specific data sought with reasonable particularity, and be issued by a court of competent jurisdiction or a properly authorized government agency. We will not comply with informal requests or demands that do not meet legal requirements.

3.2 Court Orders

A valid court order requires compliance. We review all court orders for facial validity, proper service, and jurisdictional authority. We will comply with facially valid court orders from courts of competent jurisdiction.

3.3 Search Warrants

A valid search warrant issued by a court with proper jurisdiction and based on probable cause requires compliance. We will comply with facially valid search warrants. Search warrants may, in some circumstances, include gag orders that prevent us from notifying the affected user.

3.4 Emergency Requests

In genuine emergencies involving imminent risk of death or serious physical harm, Infinite Atom may disclose limited user information to law enforcement without formal legal process. We evaluate emergency requests carefully and require a credible, documented emergency.

3.5 National Security Letters

If Infinite Atom receives a National Security Letter or similar national security demand, we will comply to the extent legally required. Applicable law may prohibit us from disclosing the receipt of such a demand.

// 4. WHAT WE WILL NOT DO

- We will not comply with informal law enforcement requests that lack legal process
- We will not install backdoors or surveillance tools in our platform
- We will not provide real-time surveillance of user activity
- We will not comply with demands from foreign governments unless required by applicable US law
- We will not comply with demands that are overbroad or lack sufficient particularity
- We will not comply with demands that appear designed to harass or surveil users without legal basis

// 5. USER NOTIFICATION

When legally permitted, Infinite Atom will notify affected users of legal demands for their data before complying. Notification allows users to seek legal counsel and potentially challenge the demand. We will not notify users when:

- A court order or statute prohibits notification
- Notification would endanger someone's safety
- Notification would compromise an active law enforcement investigation
- We are unable to locate the user for notification

// 6. PRIVATE PARTY LEGAL DEMANDS

Infinite Atom receives legal demands from private parties including civil subpoenas in litigation. We evaluate these demands for legal sufficiency and will not comply with subpoenas that are deficient, lack proper service, or seek information beyond the scope of legitimate litigation needs. We may notify affected users of private party subpoenas unless prohibited from doing so.

// 7. DATA WE HOLD

To help users and legal counsel understand what data may be subject to legal process, the following is a general description of data Infinite Atom holds:

- Account registration information — name, email, business name, city
- Authentication logs — login times and IP addresses
- Subscription and payment records through Stripe (Stripe holds payment details separately)
- Platform content — product listings, forum posts, community content
- Event submission data
- Contact form and service inquiry submissions
- AI interaction logs (if enabled)

Infinite Atom does not hold: full payment card details (held by Stripe), banking credentials, or communications between users conducted outside the platform.

// 8. COSTS

Infinite Atom reserves the right to recover reasonable costs incurred in responding to legal demands, to the extent permitted by applicable law.

// 9. SUBMITTING LEGAL DEMANDS

All legal demands must be formally served on Infinite Atom Technologies LLC. Informal requests via email will not be acted upon. Serve legal process on:

Demand must include the specific data sought, the legal authority for the demand, the case or matter identification, and contact information for the requesting party or their legal counsel.
