Platform Integrity Policy

Automated Access, Scraping, Bots & Platform Security

// 1. PURPOSE

This Platform Integrity Policy governs automated access to infinite-atom.com, protects against scraping, bot activity, and reverse engineering, and establishes the security responsibilities of all platform users. The integrity of the Platform's technology, data, and community is essential to its value for everyone.

// 2. PROHIBITED AUTOMATED ACTIVITIES

2.1 Scraping & Data Extraction

You may not use automated tools, scripts, bots, crawlers, spiders, or any other automated means to access, collect, extract, or download any data from the Platform without prior written authorization from Infinite Atom Technologies LLC. This prohibition applies to:

- Event listing data
- Partner and vendor information
- Product listings and pricing
- Community content including forum posts and showcase posts
- User profiles and contact information
- Any other data accessible through the Platform

Infinite Atom itself may use automated scraping to collect publicly available event data for the Atomic Makers Network map. This is explicitly authorized activity by the Platform operator.

2.2 Bots & Automated Interaction

You may not use bots, scripts, or automated tools to:

- Create or manage accounts
- Post content, submit forms, or interact with community features
- Generate points, votes, or other engagement metrics
- Conduct transactions or claim vendor spots
- Monitor the Platform for competitive intelligence
- Test platform security or probe for vulnerabilities

2.3 Reverse Engineering

You may not:

- Decompile, disassemble, or reverse engineer any platform software
- Attempt to access or reconstruct platform source code
- Analyze platform traffic to extract API endpoints or data structures

- Create tools that mimic or interact with platform functionality without authorization
- Use browser developer tools, network inspection, or other technical means to extract platform data at scale

2.4 Denial of Service

You may not conduct or facilitate any attack designed to degrade, disrupt, or deny access to the Platform for any user. This includes distributed denial-of-service (DDoS) attacks, credential stuffing, brute force login attempts, and resource exhaustion attacks.

// 3. AUTHORIZED AUTOMATED ACCESS

The following automated access is permitted without prior authorization:

- Standard search engine crawling for indexing publicly available pages (respects robots.txt)
- Monitoring tools used by partners to check their own stall page availability
- Accessibility tools used by individual users to interact with the Platform

Any other automated access requires prior written authorization from infiniteatomtech@gmail.com.

// 4. SECURITY RESPONSIBILITIES

4.1 User Responsibilities

All platform users are responsible for:

- Maintaining the security of their account credentials
- Using strong, unique passwords for their platform account
- Not sharing account credentials with unauthorized parties
- Reporting suspected account compromise to infiniteatomtech@gmail.com immediately
- Keeping contact information current so security alerts can reach you

4.2 Vulnerability Disclosure

If you discover a security vulnerability in the Platform, report it responsibly to infiniteatomtech@gmail.com before disclosing it publicly. Include a description of the vulnerability, the potential impact, and steps to reproduce it. Infinite Atom will acknowledge valid security reports and work to address confirmed vulnerabilities. Good faith security researchers who follow this responsible disclosure process will not face legal action for their research.

4.3 No Penetration Testing

You may not conduct penetration testing, vulnerability scanning, or security testing of the Platform without prior written authorization from Infinite Atom Technologies LLC. Unauthorized security testing may trigger automated defense responses and may be reported to law enforcement.

// 5. ROBOTS.TXT & TECHNICAL ACCESS CONTROLS

The Platform publishes a robots.txt file that specifies which areas of the Platform may be accessed by automated crawlers. Compliance with robots.txt directives is required for all automated access. Bypassing robots.txt directives is a violation of this policy and may constitute unauthorized computer access under applicable law.

// 6. CONSEQUENCES

Violations of this policy may result in:

- IP address blocking and rate limiting
- Account suspension or termination
- Legal action under the Computer Fraud and Abuse Act (18 U.S.C. Section 1030), the Ohio Computer Crimes Act, and other applicable laws
- Civil litigation for damages including lost revenue, costs of remediation, and injunctive relief
- Referral to law enforcement

// 7. RATE LIMITING

The Platform implements rate limiting on API endpoints and page requests to protect against abuse. Legitimate users will not encounter rate limits under normal usage. If you encounter rate limits during legitimate use, contact infiniteatomtech@gmail.com.
