// PURPOSE

Infinite Atom Technologies LLC operates on self-hosted residential infrastructure maintained by a single person. This is not hidden. It is the honest reality of an early-stage platform. This form exists to make sure every partner understands exactly what they are building on before they invest time, money, and energy into their vendor space.

Read each statement below. If you have questions about any of them, email infiniteatomtech@gmail.com before signing. Do not sign this form if you do not understand what it says.

STATEMENT 1 — I UNDERSTAND THIS IS A HOME CLUSTER I understand that infinite-atom.com runs on three repurposed desktop computers in a residential environment in Lancaster, Ohio, connected to a residential internet connection. This is not a data center. This is not AWS, Google Cloud, or Azure. It is a home cluster maintained by one person.

STATEMENT 2 — I UNDERSTAND THERE IS NO UPTIME GUARANTEE I understand that Infinite Atom Technologies LLC provides no Service Level Agreement and no guaranteed uptime percentage. The platform is provided on a best-effort basis. It can and will go down from time to time for both planned and unplanned reasons.

STATEMENT 3 — I UNDERSTAND A POWER OUTAGE TAKES THE SITE DOWN I understand that a power outage at the host location will take the entire platform offline immediately. There is currently no UPS backup power protecting the cluster. If the power goes out, the site goes down until power is restored and machines reboot.

STATEMENT 4 — I UNDERSTAND AN ISP OUTAGE TAKES THE SITE DOWN I understand that the platform depends on a single residential internet connection. If that connection experiences an outage, the platform is completely unreachable regardless of whether the hardware is running perfectly. Infinite Atom has no control over ISP restoration timelines.

STATEMENT 5 — I UNDERSTAND THERE ARE NO AUTOMATED BACKUPS YET I understand that as of the effective date of this document, automated backup systems have not yet been implemented. Some data loss is possible in the event of catastrophic hardware failure. I will keep local copies of my product content and not rely solely on the platform as my only copy.

STATEMENT 6 — I UNDERSTAND THERE IS ONE PERSON RUNNING THIS I understand that Infinite Atom Technologies LLC is operated by one person who is not available 24 hours a day 7 days a week. If something breaks in the middle of the night, it may not be fixed until the administrator is awake and available. This is a tradeoff I accept given the pricing.

STATEMENT 7 — I UNDERSTAND THIRD-PARTY SERVICES CAN FAIL I understand that the platform depends on Cloudflare, Supabase, Stripe, and a residential ISP — and that an outage in any of these services can take the platform offline or limit its functionality, regardless of whether the home cluster hardware is running.

STATEMENT 8 — I WILL NOT BUILD A BUSINESS THAT DEPENDS SOLELY ON THIS PLATFORM I understand that it is my responsibility to maintain a backup presence for my business independent of infinite-atom.com. I will keep copies of my content. I will have alternative ways for customers to reach me if the platform is unavailable. I accept that no single platform should be a single point of failure for my business.

STATEMENT 9 — I UNDERSTAND DOWNTIME DOES NOT AUTOMATICALLY ENTITLE ME TO A REFUND I understand that platform downtime below 72 consecutive hours does not entitle me to a subscription refund under the Refund and Cancellation Policy. Extended outages beyond 72 hours caused by Infinite Atom infrastructure failure may result in a prorated subscription credit at Infinite Atom's discretion. ISP outages, Cloudflare outages, and force majeure events are not grounds for refund.

STATEMENT 10 — I ACCEPT THIS REALITY AND CHOOSE TO BUILD HERE ANYWAY I have read the Infrastructure Transparency & Service Availability Disclosure (Document 29) in full. I understand the limitations of the current infrastructure. I understand this is an early-stage platform with a real roadmap for improvement. I choose to build here because the pricing, the community, the Ohio maker focus, and the opportunity to be an early partner outweigh the infrastructure limitations I have acknowledged above.
